Parents are also asked to **check** their child's bag each night for anything that may not belong to them. Such items may be returned in confidence to the school office.

UNIFORM SUPPORT & REMINDER

Our friendly OSHC also now run a uniform support service. This is mainly for students who arrive at school wearing non-uniform items. They will be given a ticket, and sent to the OSHC building. They will be lent a suitable piece of uniform to replace the inappropriate piece. This piece of clothing must be washed and returned to the school. This service is also used for children who may have lost a jumper, or just don't have one and may be used as a long term loan. **So please consider donating uniforms that your child has grown out of!**

Repeat instances of wearing non-uniform clothing may meet with further consequences. We took a lot of care, using your input, to create this uniform and it is an enforceable policy that the students wear it correctly.

A reminder for next term - The complete school uniform includes:

- a choice of formal checked shirt/dress or polo shirts
- a choice of shorts/culottes/skirts (jeans/denims/boardshorts are not allowed)
- a school hat (blue/red with 7cm brim)
- jewellery may include a watch & 2 pairs of stud/sleeper earrings only
- hair ties/bands must be school colours (not scarves/bandanas).
- white socks or blue tights for girls in winter

These consequences will be applied if uniform is not worn correctly:

- parents contacted & notation on class behaviour records,
- students given opportunity to borrow items from school reserve kept in OSHC block,
- after discussion with parents, persistent offenders may incur lunch time detention.

Parents may request exemptions in writing for emergent or health reasons for a short period. In anticipation of your support, we thank you and appreciate the efforts parents/carers take to ensure our students are well presented and proud to wear school uniform.

CARS BEHAVING BADLY

REMEMBER TO COME BACK TO SCHOOL NEXT TERM WITH POLITE CARS, AND GOOD ROLE MODELS FOR YOUR CHILDREN INSTEAD!

NO cars inside the school grounds at drop off and pick up times

NO parking, getting out of the car, or stopping for longer than **2 MINUTES** in the **2 Minute Zones** outside the front gate, **Patrol St** and the side gate on **Horizon Dr**

NO standing or parking in the zone outside the old Preschool between **3:00 and 3:30 pm**

NO U-Turns using school or other drive ways – that's what a round-a-bout is for

NO creating **3 LANE TRAFFIC** when driving out of Beanland St – stay on the **correct** side of the road

NO parking in either of the Good News Lutheran School parking areas

NO dropping off or picking up children while **IN LINED TRAFFIC** – you become a road hazard and your child becomes invisible to other cars

NO driving **THROUGH** the pedestrian crossing when **ANYONE** is still standing or walking on it

The above behaviours have been and are noticed on a DAILY BASIS.

Almost all are ILLEGAL.

We ALL have to drop off and pick up our children, not just you.

We ALL are in a hurry or have somewhere else to be, not just you.

BE PATIENT. BE RESPECTFUL. BE SAFE.

All members of your committee also **must** fill out a P & C register form. To obtain copies, please contact as above.

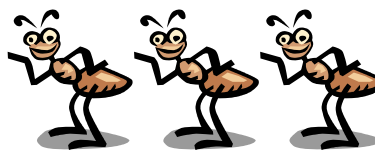
There will also be penalties, as explained last year, if financial documents, receipts etc are not filed with either the Treasurer or Bookkeeper within a fortnight of their occurrence.
