CLASS activities for Sem 2 – First Steps in Maths, Mt Ommaney Shopping Centre Enviro Bag Design competition, Tech expo 22 October. CLASS money raised at the 2008 Arts Festival to be retained by the school. TSR - 52 responses to online survey. 50 people attended the Prep Info Session, next session to be held in August. Flu update – Centenary Child Care Centre 3 closed – children excluded until Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June. Various facility including – Driveway needs speed bumps (Irena to check whether this is included in the driveway cost or extra), painters have finished painting, Prep walkway construction has begun, trees have been cut down for Prep walkway, other trees around school have dryrot and termites – new trees will be planted after the school holidays to replace these. Solar panels were installed on top of the junior covered play area and are linked to our tuckshop switchboard. Cheque for \$12780 has been presented to the P&C for parent contributions for the year.

Expenses include half the insurance and half of the audit fees and bookkeeping. It was noted that the science committee are now the PECAC committee. Irena has requested the 1<sup>st</sup> half of the parent contribution for the year - \$15000 – P&C Approved. Due to the current financial crisis next year we will look at whether the P&C can afford to give \$30000 to the school. Free dress day will be held on the first Friday of Term 3 – 17<sup>th</sup> July.
